




BIG, FAT, ALUMINUM TUBES!

The return of the Rodriguez Aluminum tandem!

Back in 1989, Rodriguez was one of the first companies to build both steel and aluminum tandems. Back then, steel tandems were much heavier, and more expensive than they are now, and aluminum was a way to save some weight at that same price. As steel evolved though, it became much lighter, and even more economical. Building techniques evolved, and with the introduction of tigwelding, building with steel became very affordable. By 1993, it was possible for us to build a steel tandem that was just as light as our aluminum tandem, and less expensive, so the aluminum Rodriguez was discontinued.

Over the years, there have been some die-hard aluminum fans that long for the old aluminum Rodriguez tandem. Well, we decided to bring back an aluminum tandem for 1999! They will be built custom for each couple. There are some differences in this tandem as compared to the old Rodriguez aluminum. It only makes sense to make an aluminum tandem if it can be lighter than a steel tandem at a comparable price.

The 1999 aluminum tandem is made of lighter, yet stiffer tubing than its predecessor. The tubing has a larger diameter, and thinner wall. The ride of a tandem like this one isn't for everyone.



The ride on this tandem is perfect for the couple who likes to ride light, stiff, aluminum road bikes. The weight savings are pretty significant. In comparison to our basic steel frame, the 1999 Aluminum weighs in 3.5 lbs less. The Aluminum tandems will sell for \$1999 (introductory price) for a frame/fork in a single color paint job, or as little as \$2999 for a complete tandem ready to ride. That's less than the production models of 1989 were introduced at!

We've got one at the shop available for test rides. Come in and try it out today!

Our favorite lighting system of all time!

Every year at R&E Cycles, we sell lots & lots of lighting systems to cyclists who ride in the dark. In the winter, it is dark at 5.00 PM, and some people like to have the finest lighting system available.




